4. Details on the programme

4.1. Introduction to the new features of DPS

- Media manager (create media projects and link them to dictionaries);
- Link/predicates manager across content and media databases (manage link types such as synonym of, definition of, see also, geographical topics, origin of);
- Global use of metadata and extended search and retrieve capabilities across XML content and metadata;
- Processing instructions and use of internal IDs;
- Publication editor (create composed pages to preview and proofread content aggregation);
- XML online/offline editor (edit XML content, publication tree, metadata, categories, etc.)
- Generate reports for quality control;
- Deliver content in print (InDesign) and digital formats including eBooks (EPUB3, EDUPUB, KF8, MOBI), Learning Management Platforms, etc.
- Integrate user generated content;
- Process manager and scheduler to schedule on-demand and/or periodic data processing.
